



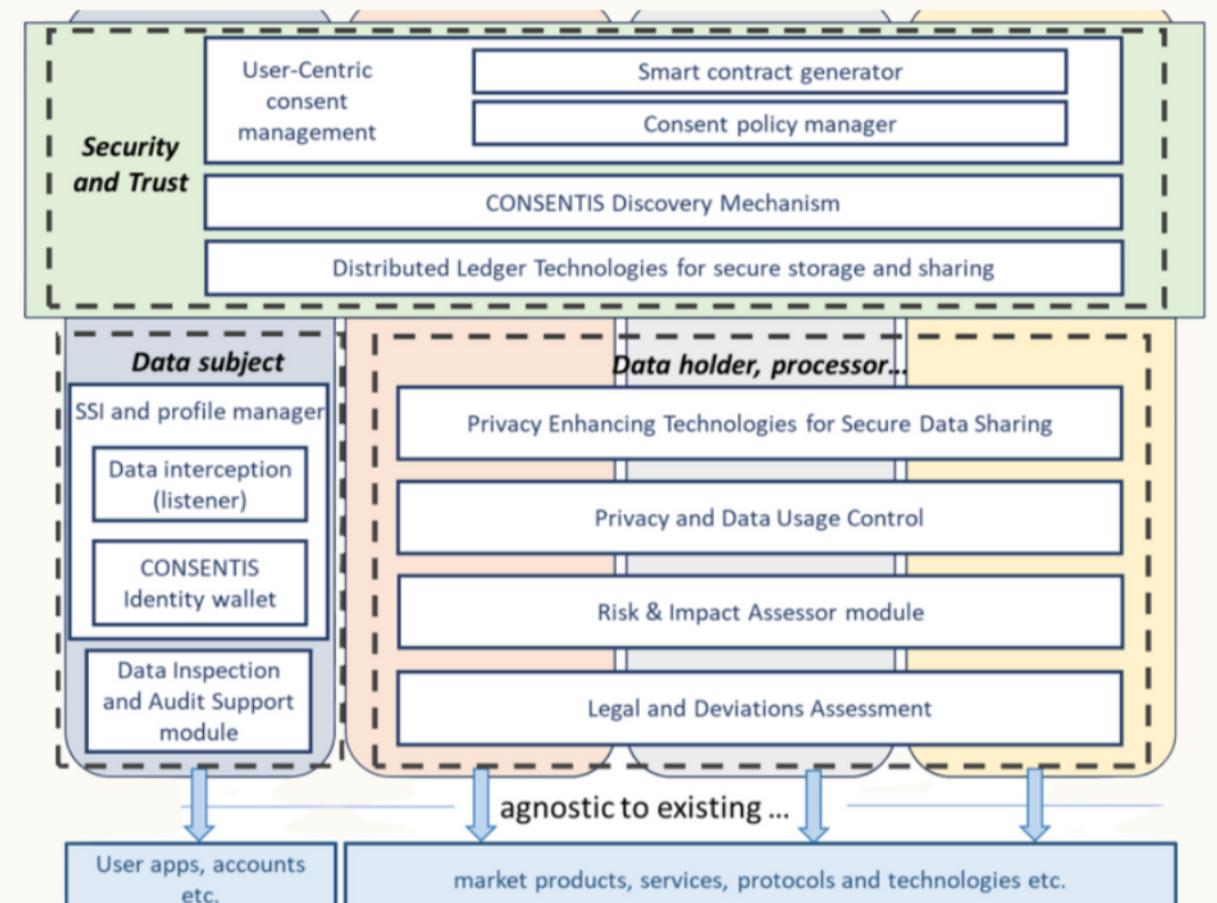
# CONSENTIS

## Identity and Consent Management for EU Digital and Data Strategies

### INTRODUCTION

CONSENTIS envisions a transformative approach to personal data sharing that aligns with EU regulations and strategic initiatives, including eIDAS, EU Data Spaces, and GDPR. The project introduces a novel framework that empowers individuals with self-sovereign identity and user-centric consent management solutions, enabling them to: a) exercise full control over the collection and use of their personal data, and b) provide informed consent seamlessly through intuitive interfaces and timely notifications. CONSENTIS is an industry-oriented project, with SMEs and large companies covering more than 80% of the consortium and is built on a collaboration of 12 organisations from 10 EU member states and associated countries.

### OBJECTIVES

- Address the critical issues of identity management, consent management, and personal information sharing and usage between diverse contexts, technologies, and administrative domains.
- Deliver a complete framework agnostic to existing services and technologies that enables users (data subjects) to keep control of their identity information and monitor data sharing and processing.
- Align CONSENTIS solutions with EU strategic initiatives and regulations and boost the EU data economy and innovation capacity of EU digital and data strategies.
- Validate CONSENTIS identity solutions in multiple scenarios involving data transferring and processing across diverse actors, domains and contexts.
- Connect with external stakeholders (industry, academia, policy makers and regulators) to promote project results and receive valuable feedback. Aim for high societal and market impact.

### ALIGNMENT WITH EU REGULATORY FRAMEWORK

- General Data Protection Regulation (GDPR):
  - Freely given, specific, informed and unambiguous consent. Granting and withdrawing consent via a digital wallet.
- Regulation on electronic identification and trust services for electronic transactions in the internal market (eIDAS):
  - Integration with existing Trust Service Providers to verify users' identities.
- Regulation establishing a framework for a European Digital Identity (EUDI Framework):
  - Development of the CONSENTIS Identity Wallet to facilitate consent management.
- European Health Data Space Regulation (EHDS):
  - Validation scenarios involving primary and secondary uses of health data.
- Data Governance Act (DGA):
  - Data intermediation service providers (Personal Information Management System).
- Data Act (DA):
  - Interoperability and smart contract requirements.
