The Tilburg Institute for Law, Technology, and Society (TILT) is a research institute of Tilburg University and a top player in the field of the regulation and governance of technology, especially the legal, social, and normative implications of emerging technologies. Established in 1994, TILT has built a reputation in the domain and is consistently ranked among top institutes for research and education by both national and international Legal Research and Education Assessment Committees.

TILT is a multidisciplinary research institute combining law, philosophy, social sciences, public administration, informatics, and management sciences, which enables research that delivers valuable new insights to the existing body of knowledge at the

intersection of law, technology, and society. TILT's collaborative and open environment stimulates social and intellectual interchange. TILT is unique in being a large institution (around 70 researchers from around the world), yet truly multidisciplinary and collaborative.

TILT's research is performed within large international (EU-funded), national (NWO and publicly-privately funded) and commissioned (by EU institutions and national government bodies) projects. TILT's input in these projects is guided by an overarching research program, "Regulating Socio-Technical Change".
